While these awards are far from covering the entire expense of a year of graduate study, they do offer vital supplementary support allowing students working on their dissertation ro undertake essential research travel or to devote full time to research and writing without the need for distracting employment.

Through your generosity last year, we made awards to three outstanding doctoral students: Greyson Abid, Mary Mussman and Talia Prussin.. Grevson is pursuing a Ph.D. in Philosophy. His dissertation is on "Recognition: The Interface Between Perception and Prior Knowledge." Mary is pursuing a Ph.D. in Comparative Literature. Her dissertation is entitled "Intimate Literatures: Queer Femininity, Pragmatics, Community." Talia's Ph.D. studies are in Ancient History & Mediterranean Archaeology. Her dissertation is titled "This Land is Our Land: Financing Empires Before and After Alexander." Greyson is grateful for the fellowship and reports: "With the help of a Phi Beta Kappa fellowship, I will be able to finish my dissertation over the coming summer. I will also be able to more deeply research the empirical literature adjacent to my field, a task that would not have been possible if I were simultaneously teaching during that period."
